Nose: Torrontés wines are known for their aromatic intensity and this wine is no exception, showing expressive varietal aromas of jasmine and rose.

Palate: The palate is built around a firm steely acid core with fleshy fruit on the front palate and spicy texture on the finish.

Notes: Torrontés is Argentina's most celebrated white grape and one that is gaining the attention of wine critics around the world. Torrontés wines are known for their aromatic intensity, smooth texture and fine cleansing acidity. Fine examples of Torrontes are being produced in the cool climate of Mendoza's Uco Valley.

Food Pairing: Jasmin aromas and zingy acidity make Torrontés almost seem custom-made to contemporary Asian cuisine.

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
